







Design Direction Package:

Create or redefine a project with the most cohesive and dynamic design by ensuring that all design decisions support a unified vision.

- Onsite Review of existing structure or presentation by designers of a new project.
- 2. Market and competition review
- Impact Diagrams to help determine which components should have more expensive materials and bolder colors to catch the eye of potential tenants. Building size, massing, detail complexity, material variety and landscape structures will affect the time required /cost of completing this component.
- 4. Design Composite Sheet based on regional and neighborhood style and character study and prospective tenants interest and lifestyle. This step gives the design team a visual representation for the unified design vision.
- 5. Review, direction, and facilitation of collaboration meetings to ensure consistent design decisionmaking among all design trades involved in the project, including Architect, Interior Designer, Landscape Architect, Sign Designer, Web and Print Marketing, and design coordination with MEP engineers.

- 2. 3 Color scheme recommendations/presentation including paint, cabinet, countertops, flooring, plumbing, and light fixture recommendations.
- 3. Finish Schedule & Placement Diagrams (Detail complexity and material variety will affect the budget of this component).
- *Estimates available after initial meeting and/or on-site review.
- *Each of the services listed can be provided individually on an hourly basis.
- *As-builts and/or up to date design/construction drawings, description of potential tenants expectations, budget/ level of finish direction, and list of perceived competitive projects are necessary to begin.
